NYPD — Electronic Identification Program

Today everyone, from young children to seniors, are carrying a cell phone, mp3 player or hand held electronic game. Many of these devices are accidentally lost but more and more students and adults are becoming victims of crimes where their electronic devices are being taken from their bags, lockers or persons. When a device is stolen or lost, we report it to the police but more often than not we do not know the vital information needed to help recover our property. Most of us remember the brand name of our cell phone or mp3 player, but do you know or save the serial number located inside the device? The answer is usually NO. So how can you protect your property from theft? Here are a few suggestions.

Protect your cell phones, mp3 players and favorite games.

• Never leave your items unattended on a desk or in a public area.

• Be aware of your surroundings when walking outside using your phone, mp3 player, or game.

• Secure items in a locked closet or cabinet while at work or school.

• Leave them home. Don't take these items to school or work if you don't need them.



WHAT CAN I DO?

You can register your electronics now. Use the form on the next page and fill out the information for the type of electronic device you want to register. You can use the same form to register more than one device. This information will then be added to a database and in the event that you lose or have your property stolen, the information will be available and make it easier to return it when it is found or recovered.



Locate the serial number or IMEI number under the battery.

HOW DO I REGISTER?

Just fill out the form on the next page and return it to your school, mail it, or email the information to the addresses on the back of the brochure. We will add your device to our database and safeguard your information so that if you lose your electronic device or if it is stolen, the information will already be on file. When filling out the form, be sure to include as much information as possible. The serial numbers or IMEI numbers are usually located inside the device. Simply open the battery compartment, take out the battery, locate the serial numbers and write the numbers down on the form. If you don't want to give your address, simply provide your home phone number or school so that we can contact you when your property is recovered.
