



Lab Make Up Policy

The State requires each student to successfully complete 1200 minutes of laboratory work in order to qualify and or sit for the science regents. This amounts to successfully completing 15 labs per term (with each lab being 44 minutes).

If a student misses a lab, he/she can then make-up that lab with another lab section (with the teacher's permission in advance) and/or **during makeup sessions as per the schedule posted outside room 513, during the same or the following week, provided that:**

1. The absence was due to valid reasons and **not due to cutting or lateness.**
2. Excused absences (accompanied by a note from home) due to reasons other than sickness are limited to 2 per term.
3. The lab section does not exceed 34 students.

In situations where a student is out for a prolonged period of time ***due to illness (with the proper documentation and communication with the class teacher)***, the Dept. Chairperson and or lab teacher will provide an opportunity for the student to make up the necessary labs.
